Côtes-du-Rhône Villages Cairanne

## PRESENTATION AND TERROIRS

On the left side of the Rhône, in the Vaucluse, the village of Cairanne shares with Rasteau a beautiful hill. Hillsides are watching the south and the west and come down on the “Plan de Dieu”, on a poor soil, very stony, called by the local winemakers “garrigues”. The Jubain family cultivates 40 hectares of vines in Cairanne since a very long time. Some Grenache are more than hundred years old, some syrah are 60 years old. Soil is plowed but not weeded.

Grenache 60%  
Syrah 20%  
Carignan 10%  
Cinsault 5%  
Mourvèdre 5%

## VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Patrice makes wine in a very traditional way; 100% matured in tank, without yeast addition and without cold temperature control process of the fermentation. What we liked at once in those wines is the robustness of Cairanne with a lot of fruit, power, a round and silky mouth, a beautiful aromatic complexity in a velvet glove:
